## Rules for Presentation

- There are no required times for official poster presentations; however, poster presenters are encouraged to be standing by your poster during the breaks and lunches to be able to discuss your poster with attendees.

## Poster Sizes

- This will be an E-Poster in PDF format, portrait orientation with the following details:
  - Poster Title
  - Name of the Author
  - Name of the Co-Author
  - Name of the Institute/Organisation
  - Background
  - Methodology
  - Results/Conclusions/Inference
  - Contact Details
- The E-Poster could be of maximum 6 pages.

## Compliance Criteria

1. Posters must be free of commercial bias:
  - (a) All treatment/management recommendations must be based on strongest levels of evidence available;
  - (b) Presentations must give a balanced view of therapeutic options. Use of generic names will contribute to this impartiality. If the CME educational material or content includes trade names, trade names from several companies, where available, should be used, not just trade names from a single company.
2. Do not use corporate brand names or organizational logos on your poster.
3. All information that could potentially be used to identify a patient must NOT be included in the presentation/poster.
4. Posters must not contain any offensive comments or images (i.e., vulgarities, obscenities, etc.).

Abstract presenters and authors, whether oral or posters, in the Scientific Sessions at the IFSO APC 2017 Goa, India are required to register for the Scientific Sessions, and are expected to pay the registration fee.
